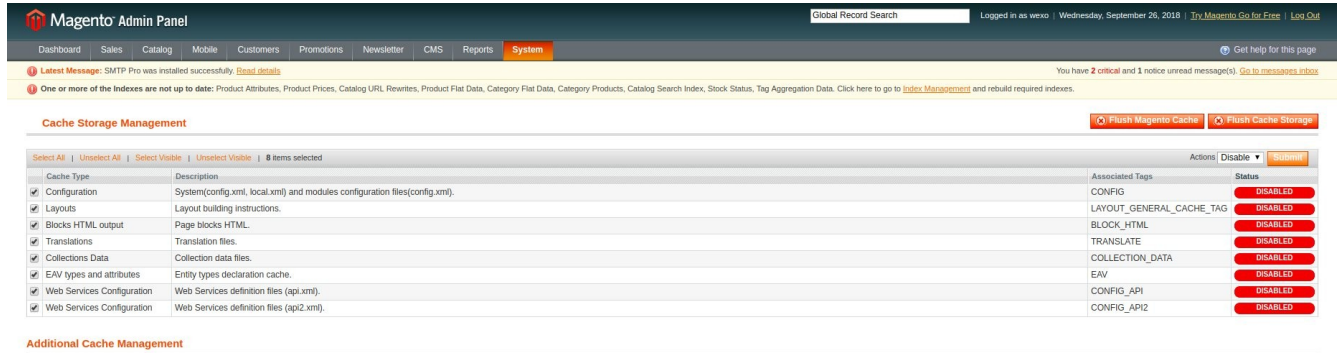
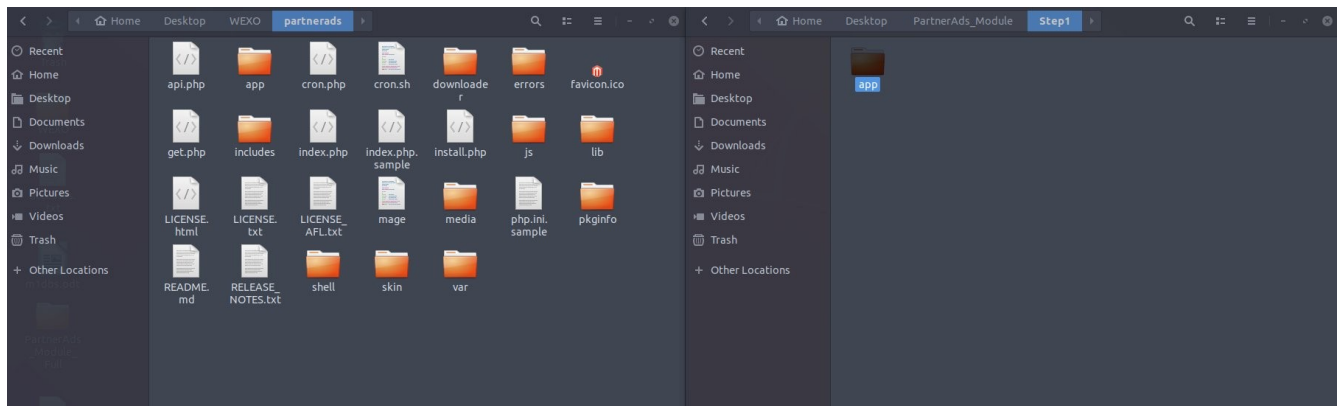


PartnerAds Module Magento 1.9.x.x Installation Guide

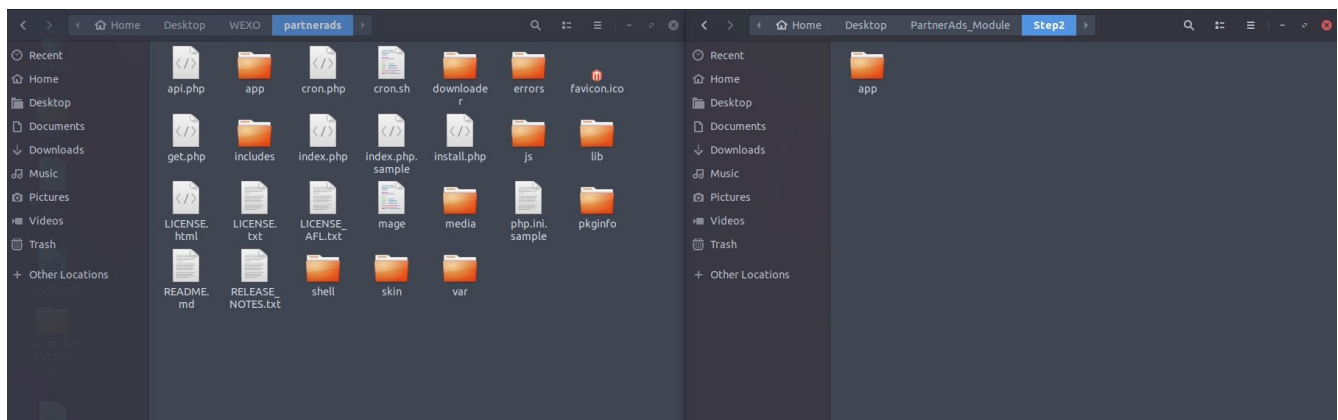
1. Unzip PartnerAds_Module.zip
2. Turn off the Magento One caches from Admin → System → Cache Management



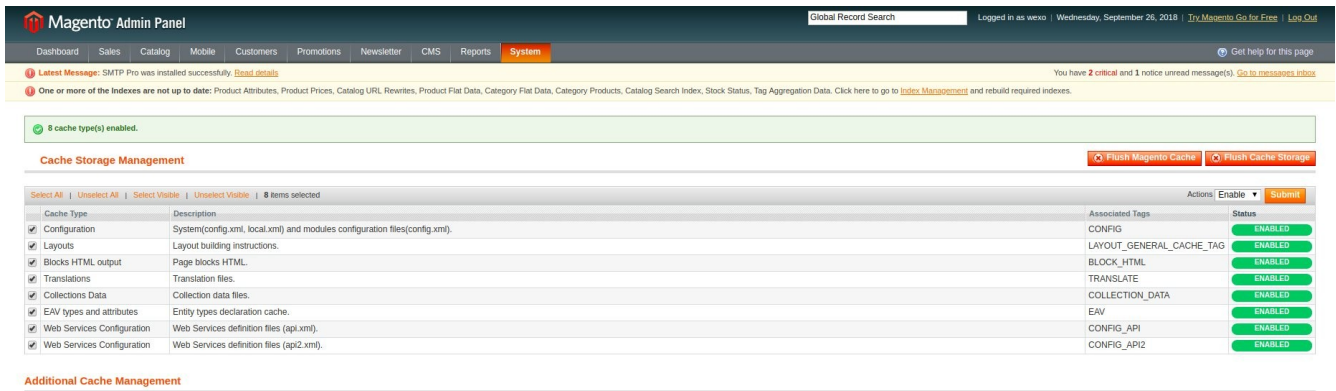
3. Copy the content of Step1 folder inside your Magento installation folder



4. Copy the content of Step2 folder inside your Magento installation folder



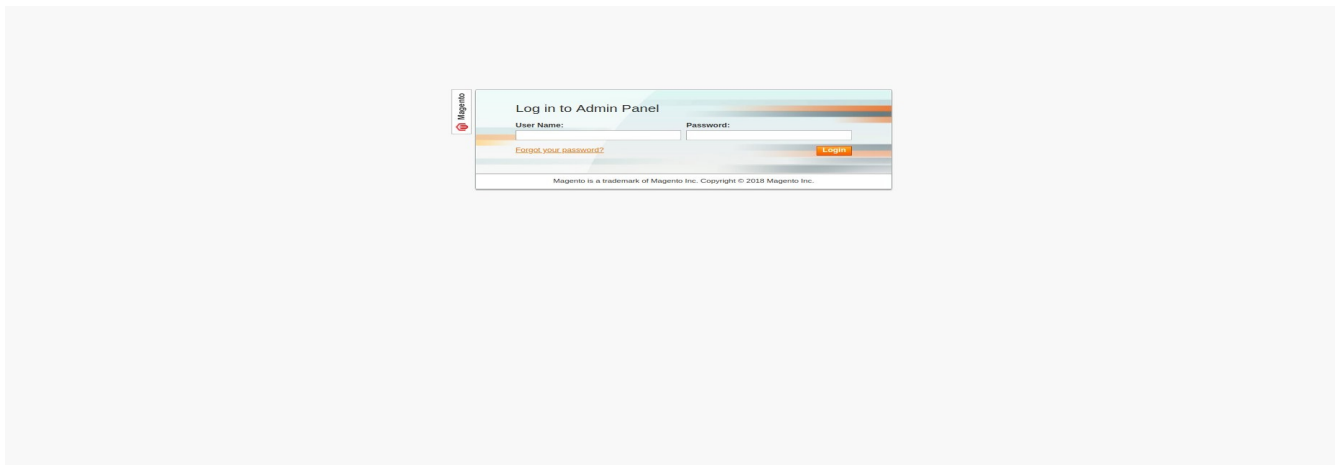
5. Turn on the Magento One caches
